Work to Residence Visa

Early Childhood Education (ECE) qualified teachers are now included on Immigration New Zealand's Green List as Tier 2 roles.*

This means you're eligible to apply for a Work to Residence Visa after two years of work experience, provided you earn the current median wage of \$31.61 NZD in 2024.
